**Walk-in-Interview for Recruitment of Medical Officer (Retired PCMS officers)**

The Punjab State AIDS Control Society (PSACS) invites applications from retired PCMS officers for the post of Medical Officer to be filled on a contractual basis under the National AIDS Control Programme in Anti-retroviral Therapy (ART) Centres and Oral Substitution Therapy (OST) Centres.

**Number of vacancies:** There are five vacancies to be filled by Medical Officer (retired PCMS officers) strictly based on the reservation roster. Table 1 below provides the total and the category-wise number of vacancies. Candidates from other categories shall not be considered.

**Salary:** The Medical Officers shall be paid a consolidated salary of 72,000 per month.

**Place of posting:** The Medical Officer (retired PCMS officers) after the due process of selection shall be considered for posting in the following locations: *Amritsar, Jalandhar, Ludhiana, Sangrur, and Jagraon*. Selection doesn't guarantee the place of posting.

**Maximum age limit:** The maximum age limit to apply for the post of Medical Officer (retired PCMS officers) is 65 years.

**Qualifications and experience:** The essential and desirable qualification and the essential experience for Medical Officers (retired PCMS officers) is shown in Table 2.

**Date and time for walk-in interview:** *10<sup>th</sup> August 2023, Thursday from 9 am to 3 pm.* PSACS will not entertain candidates after 3 pm on 10<sup>th</sup> August. There will be no written test or interview for the Medical Officer (retired PCMS officers) post.

**Location for walk-interview:** Interested candidates may appear in the office of Punjab State AIDS Control Society, Prayaas Building, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Sector-38-B, Chandigarh along with the following documents:

- Original certificates/testimonials for document verification
- Attested copies of all the relevant academic certificates/experience certificates or pension certificate
- Certificate of category claimed issued by Punjab Government
- Two recent passport-size photographs.

**Criteria to determine merit:** If there are multiple candidates in each category, merit shall be determined based on the inter-se seniority of the retired PCMS Officers in the MO/SMO seniority list of the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Punjab. The place of posting shall also be determined by the inter-se seniority of the selected candidates.

**Other important terms and conditions:**

- a. The candidate should have passed Punjabi up to Matric standard or its equivalent standard from any recognized institution/Board or should have passed the Punjabi Language Proficiency Test conducted by the Department of Languages, Government of Punjab.
- b. The number of posts is subject to increase or decrease as per the decision of the Project Director, PSACS.
- c. These posts are purely **contractual and temporary for one year**, extendable based on work performance and conduct.

- d. If a candidate is found not to be fulfilling the eligibility/selection criteria at any point of time in the entire recruitment process by the screening or selection committee, his/her candidature will be canceled/rejected for the said post.
- e. Candidates **will not be paid any TA/DA** for document verification.
- f. Project Director, PSACS, reserves the right to cancel/modify the entire recruitment process at any stage without issuing any further notice.
